 - d) The example of Apollos – Acts 18:24-28. What lessons can we learn from the experience of Apollos?
 - e) The example of Paul in Athens – Acts 17:16-21 , 22-34. What lessons do you learn from this story?
 - f) What essential preparation is needed to effectively minister to people in urban areas?
 - 2) Hearing the cry of those in the cities
 - a) Exodus 2:23-25; Exodus 6:5
 - b) Psalm 12:5
 - c) Jonah 4:10-11
 - d) 2 Peter 3:9
 - e) 1 Timothy 2:4
 - f) How can we become more sensitive to the needs of those living in our cities?
 - g) What opportunities and challenges will we face if our hearts reflect the caring heart of God?
 - h) Share a time when you heard someone’s cry in the city.

 - a) Matthew 13:3-9 – This is a story about farming but it also relates to urban ministry. What types of soil are present in the cities?
 - b) What are some practical ways we can prepare the soil in urban areas for a great harvest?
 - c) Share an experience of doing seed sowing and soil cultivation in a city environment.
 - 4) Connecting in a personal way in an impersonal city
 - a) In cities, we find many isolated people even though they walk on crowded streets.
 - b) How do the following texts help us to discover ways of connecting with people in urban areas?
