- 1) Touching the Untouchable
 - a) Matthew 8:1-4
 - b) Some taught that all lepers were under the judgment of God (Numbers 12:9-12). How would you respond?
 - c) What can we learn from the confession of the leper?
 - d) Jesus didn't need to touch the leper. What was the significance of His healing touch?
 - e) Why did Jesus instruct the leper not to broadcast the news that Jesus had healed him?
 - f) What lessons can we learn from Jesus about touching the untouchable?
- 2) The Roman Centurion's faith
 - a) Matthew 8:5-13
 - b) Why does Matthew record this miracle of Jesus? Is it just about a soldier's servant being healed?
 - c) What is the significance of the words of Jesus recorded in Matthew 8:10-12 for our lives today?
- 3) The testimony of a healed life
 - a) Matthew 8:28-34
 - b) What story in Matthew's Gospel precedes the healing of these two demoniacs? Matthew 8:23-27
 - c) What is the relationship between these two miracles and why does Matthew record both of them?
 - d) Both Mark (5:1-20) and Luke (8:26-29) record the healing of the demoniacs. Why was this miracle so important? What lesson does Jesus want us all to learn?
 - e) Evil forces oppress many today. What encouragement can we receive from this miracle of Jesus? (John 10:10)
 - f) Matthew 8:34 – Satan tried to hinder the ministry of Jesus in that region. How did Jesus respond? (Luke 8:38-39)
- 4) Spiritual healing and physical healing
 - a) Which is more important—physical healing or spiritual healing?
 - b) Matthew 9:1-8
 - c) What important truth is Jesus teaching in the healing of the paralytic?
 - d) How does the faith of the friends impact this man in need of healing? (Matthew 8:2)
 - e) Share a time when someone helped you to find healing by bringing you to Jesus.
- 5) Extending the healing ministry of Jesus
 - a) Matthew 9:18-26 –Desperate need for healing all around us.
 - b) Matthew 10:8 – the command of Jesus
 - c) What are your thoughts about extending the healing ministry of Jesus?
