 - d) Some struggle with belief in unseen realities. What evidence is there that this great controversy between good and evil is still very real today?

- 2) The advancing of the kingdom of heaven
 - a) In the teachings of Jesus, the kingdom of heaven is both a present reality (Matthew 4:17) and a future reality (Matthew 26:29). What promises in God's Word assure us that the kingdom of heaven will move forward in the midst of this great controversy between good and evil?
